

Signs of cuckooing:

- You haven't seen the person who lives at the address recently, or other people appear to be living there
- Lots of different people coming and going from a property during the day and at night
- Suspicious smells coming from the property
- Windows covered or curtains closed all of the time
- Cars pulling up to or near to the property for a short period of time
- An increase in anti-social behaviour around the property

How can you help?

- Make sure you know the signs to look out for
- Work with us by reporting anything suspicious straight away
